AUGMENTATION

Breast augmentation surgery involves using breast implants or fat, referred to as fat transfer breast augmentation, to increase the size of your breasts or restore breast volume that has been lost after weight reduction or pregnancy. Breast augmentation can: increase fullness and projection of your breasts; improve the balance of your figure; enhance your self-image and self-confidence. Breast implants may also be used for breast reconstruction after mastectomy or injury.

RECONSTRUCTION

Breast reconstruction is achieved through several plastic surgery techniques that attempt to restore a breast to near normal shape, appearance and size following mastectomy.

LIFT

A breast lift raises the breasts by removing excess skin and tightening the surrounding tissue to reshape and support the new breast contour. A breast lift can rejuvenate your figure with a breast profile that is more youthful and uplifted. A woman's breasts often change over time, losing their youthful shape and firmness. These changes and loss of skin elasticity can result from: pregnancy, breastfeeding, weight fluctuations, aging, gravity and heredity.

REDUCTION

Breast reduction surgery removes excess breast fat, glandular tissue and skin to achieve a breast size in proportion with your body. Many women with overly large breasts experience neck, back and shoulder pain as well as rashes under breasts. Reducing the size of the breasts helps to alleviate the discomfort associated with large breasts.
