

PSYCHIATRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM

Penn Highlands Healthcare Psychiatry Residency Program offers inpatient and outpatient training to prepare residents for a career in Psychiatry (or Behavioral Health Medicine).

Supported by the LECOMT OPTI, ACGME accreditation and working in conjunction with Family Medicine Residency Program.

Penn Highlands Healthcare is an eight-hospital system with one mission to improve regional access to quality health care while supporting quality of life for our community members. We continue to build a culture of a Community teaching hospital maintaining a one on one training with attending physicians between 2 residency programs and graduate medical education students.

Penn Highlands offers a variety of inpatient and outpatient Behavioral Health Services to treat the unique Mental Health concerns of patients including children ages 5 and up, adolescents and teens, adults, and seniors. **Services provided include but are not limited to:**

- Detox for Substance abuse
- Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT)
- Medication Management
- MH Assessment
- Outpatient Group Therapy
- Psychiatric Evaluations
- Psychological Assessment
- Psychotherapy including: Cognitive
- Behavioral Therapy, Individual Therapy, and Family Therapy
- Suicide Risk Assessment and prevention

Penn Highlands offers specialized inpatient programs operating 24/7 for children and adolescents, ages 5 to 18, who are exhibiting behavioral problems impairing their ability to function in the home and/or school. Inpatient child and adolescent services are offered at Penn Highlands DuBois.

Adult inpatient services offers treatment of emotional and behavioral difficulties experienced by individuals 18 years and older. Adult inpatient services are offered at Penn Highlands Brookville, Penn Highlands DuBois, and Penn Highlands Huntingdon.

Geriatric services treats patients 55 years and older dealing with mental health disorders or emotional breakdowns. Inpatient services are offered at Senior Transitions at Penn Highlands Brookville, Bright Horizons Center for Emotional Wellness at Penn Highlands Clearfield and Penn Highlands DuBois.

Outpatient services are designed to relieve emotional and personal distress for patients of all ages through counseling therapies, psychological assessment, individual and family psychotherapy, psychiatry evaluation, and medication management.

Penn Highlands Behavioral Health Services is backed by all the advanced services and specialties of Penn Highlands DuBois, one of the region's top hospitals. This places our patients in close proximity for routine and emergency diagnosis and multidisciplinary medical care.

NEW STATE-OF-THE-ART CENTER FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Penn Highlands Healthcare is at the pulse of the region's behavioral health needs with the opening of the Stern Center for Behavioral Health. Located at Penn Highlands DuBois East, this new \$22 million hospital offers unparalleled inpatient and outpatient therapeutic care to help children and adolescents manage their emotions and deal with life situations. A staff of licensed professionals develops individualized and structured treatment plans using a multidisciplinary approach to address the unique behavioral health needs of children and adolescents. In addition, the new Center will offer addiction medicine, and expanded outpatient behavioral health services for adults.

The next phase of this project, which will total \$39 million, includes the addition of 22 adult beds, an eight-bed high acuity unit and renovation of the existing 20 beds on the second floor for the substance abuse treatment unit. When the project is completed, the Penn Highlands Stern Center for Behavioral Health will offer a total of 118 child, adolescent and adult beds in the Penn Highlands Stern Center for Behavioral Health in DuBois.
